Beverly Bond has blazed trails in the music, entertainment and social entrepreneurship industries. Her body of work, across sectors, has made her one of the most celebrated DJ's, and social innovators of our time. Over the last decade, Bond, a former Wilhelmina model, has brought her

versatile talents to the most highly exclusive events and to a myriad of celebrity clients including Prince, Alicia Keys, Erykah Badu, Sean "Diddy" Combs, Jay Z, and more.

In 2006, Bond founded BLACK GIRLS ROCK!, a youth empowerment mentoring organization. She simultaneously created the annual BLACK GIRLS ROCK! Awards to celebrate the accomplishments of exceptional women of color who have made outstanding contributions in their careers and stand as inspirational and positive role models in the community.

Beverly's work as a businesswoman, mentor, philanthropist and community leader has earned her a number of prestigious recognitions. EBONY magazine listed Bond amongst their Power 100 list from 2008-2012, making it five consecutive years that Bond was

recognized as one of Ebony's "Most Influential Blacks In America." Bond was also recognized as one of ESSENCE magazine's "40 Fierce and Fabulous Women Who are Changing the World."



JoAnn Price is the co-founder of Fairview Capital, a leading company that provides solutions tailored to the needs of institutional investors. Prior to co-founding Fairview, Price served as president of the National Association

of Investment Companies, headquartered in Washington, D.C. A strong community advocate, Price serves on a number of national advisory committees and private equity advisory boards. She is currently on the Howard University Board of Visitors and the YMCA of Greater Hartford Board of Directors. Price also serves as the Vice Chair of the Apollo Theater Foundation and the Chairperson of the Amistad Center for Art & Culture in Hartford, Connecticut. A woman of many talents, Price is a graduate of Howard University.

Shonda Rhimes is an outstanding and extremely talented television producer and writer. Rhimes is the creator, head writer, executive producer and

showrunner of the medical drama television series Grev's Anatomy, the political thriller series Scandal, and the legal hit, How to Get Away With Murder. The consummate educator, Rhimes attended Marian Catholic High School in Chicago Heights,



Illinois, before enrolling at Dartmouth College, where she majored in English and film studies and earned her bachelor's degree in 1991. She subsequently relocated to Los Angeles to attend the University of Southern California to study screenwriting. While at USC she was hired by Debra Martin Chase as an intern. Rhimes credits her early success in part to mentors like a prominent African-American producer, who hired her as an intern at Denzel Washington's production company, Mundy Lane Entertainment. Rhimes also obtained a Master of Fine Arts degree from the USC School of Cinematic Arts. Early in her career, Rhimes worked in advertising at McCann Erickson. She is talented beyond means.

Beverly Bond, JoAnn Price and Shonda Rhimes, are black women who are making history. The indelible marks that they are leaving in this nation will be forever imprinted in our hearts.

Campbell currently serves on the boards for Georgia State University's Robinson College of Business, Barnes & Noble and Potbelly Corporation. In 2014, Campbell was named to Fortune Magazine's list of the "40 Most Powerful Women in Business."
